



PERSONAL VEHICLE POLICY

The use of personal transportation vehicles (as described below) will be allowed by members only under the following conditions:

DEFINITION OF PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE SHALL BE:

Any four wheel golf cart type vehicle (no ATV's) designed to transport at least two people. Noise level is not to exceed that of a standard automobile. They must have lights front and rear when lights are required.

RULES:

Personal transportation vehicle must be operated by a licensed member

Age restrictions:

1. Any 16-18 year old licensed and insured driver can operate a Lake Warren registered personal vehicle with only one non-related passenger
2. Any 16-18 year old licensed and insured driver can operate a Lake Warren registered personal vehicle with siblings as many as number of seats on the personal vehicle

All Illinois driving rules of the road that apply to automobiles will apply to the operation of a personal transportation vehicle

The personal transportation vehicle may not carry more passengers than that of the manufacturer's recommendation. The number of seats = number of passengers (including driver).

The personal transportation vehicles must have 3" owners lot number visible front and back at all times.

A provided sticker is to be displayed next to the front lot number

An annual fee, to be determined by the board, will be assessed at the time the sticker is applied for.

The personal transportation vehicle is to be operated on the road ways and on access areas only to access a boat dock or activity the operator is unable to walk to.

Proof of insurance must be submitted with the request for sticker

Privileges to operate a personal transportation vehicle can be immediately revoked by any two board members under the following conditions:

- Violation of any of the above rules
- Trespassing on leaseholder's property without permission
- Horseplay

If privileges are revoked, the owner must appear the board for consideration of restored privileges.
